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**MTU Aero Engines benefits from large V2500 deals signed in Dubai**

- **V2500 a hot selling new sales and aftersales item**

Munich – The V2500 engine continues its winning streak. At the Dubai Airshow 2005, which closed yesterday, more than 150 engines of this type were ordered, worth totally a billion euros for the International Aero Engines (IAE) consortium. Germany's engine manufacturer MTU Aero Engines, too, benefits from the Dubai contracts, to the tune of 100 million euros. A co-founder of the IAE consortium, which was launched over 20 years ago, MTU is the world's leading MRO company for the V2500. The V2500 has been a very popular engine for years. So far, over 5,000 engines have been sold, of which 2,700 have already been delivered.

The biggest single order came from the U.S. leasing company ILFC, which ordered up to 45 V2500-powered A320 family airplanes. 30 A320 transports were ordered by the Indian low-cost carrier Kingfisher, and they will be equipped with IAE engines as well. Both airlines have had positive prior experience with the engine. The third order was from Royal Jordanian Airlines, which in its fleet renewal campaign also opted for the V2500-powered Airbus transport, adding six new jetliners to its present seven-aircraft fleet.

With its 6,700 employees, MTU Aero Engines is Germany's leading engine manufacturer and one of the big players in the industry. It is the world's largest independent provider of commercial engine maintenance services. Technologically, too, the company has won a global leadership position.

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
