
MTU Maintenance Berlin-Brandenburg has been awarded an Agreement with STATOIL, Norsk Hydro, and ExxonMobile Norway for the Service and Maintenance of GE LM Gas Turbines used in offshore and onshore applications in Norway

Ludwigsfelde, Germany - MTU Maintenance Berlin-Brandenburg has been awarded an agreement valued at approximately Nkr 350 Mill. (appr. 42 Mill. €) to provide maintenance services for GE LM gas turbines used in offshore platforms in the North Sea and onshore facilities located in Norway. The sites are owned and operated by oil exploration companies STATOIL ASA, a Norwegian company based in Stavanger, Norway, Norsk Hydro Produksjon AS and Exxon Mobile Exploration and Production Norway AS.

Under the terms of the agreement, MTU will provide maintenance and repair services for planned and unplanned maintenance of appr. 40% of the entire fleet of GE LM gas turbines in operation. The agreement will cover a maintenance period of three years. All of the units are originally manufactured by GE and are used mainly for oil&gas-production as well as for power-production.

"Our goal is to deliver optimal solutions to ensure reliable operation and mitigate the associated risks," said André Wall, CEO of MTU Maintenance Berlin-Brandenburg. "We put clear focus on our customer's needs and we are dedicated to provide first-class performance and high flexibility over the life of the agreement."

MTU Maintenance Berlin-Brandenburg is an affiliate of MTU Aero Engines. The company focuses on small and mid-size aircraft engines and on industrial gas turbines. It also does the final assembly of most low-pressure turbines manufactured by MTU. The company plays a very special role in the TP400-D6 program, the engine to power the Airbus A400M military airlifter. Ludwigsfelde has Europe's only production test cell to conduct TP400-D6 development and acceptance test runs. Final assembly of the European TP400-D6 production engines, too, will be performed exclusively at the MTU affiliate.
